

Programme Aims

Kolbe Pre-school achieves these objectives by utilising individually devised Programmes which ensures that each child is given the means and opportunity to:

- Develop communication skills through Speech & Language programmes.
- Develop physically through Physiotherapy and Physical Exercises
- Develop emotionally by treating each child with respect and dignity
- Develop psychologically by providing the necessary support and encouragement needed for each child.
- ♣ Develop multiple skills using information and assistive technology.
- Develop means of relaxation, stimulation and socialising through music.
- Develop self-help skills.
- Develop sensory awareness through snoezelen, massage and aromatherapy techniques.
